Welcome to the seventh annual Streatham Food Festival, brought to you by InStreatham. Over the five days of the festival we will showcase the many culinary delights Streatham has to offer, enjoy delicious dishes from local food businesses, join community groups for fresh food demos and try something new at one of the Festival's very special events.

This year sees the return of the popular Streatham Food Tour which, now in its fourth year, introduces taster menus from around 30 local restaurants – the perfect way to taste the flavours of the world right here in Streatham. For the first time ever there is a food tour for toddlers too, highlighting the best children's menus in the area. So grab your Food Tour scorecards and tickle those taste buds!

The schools recipe competition is also back for the second year, with a focus on healthy, tasty, dishes that represent the cultural mix of the community. The winning dish will be announced and cooked at the Sunday Food Fair on 19 June. Held at Streatham Green, the Food Fair will see a mix of street food stalls and tasty sweet treats, plus entertainment from from choirs Sing Out Streatham and Bellows Fellows, a live mural creation, face painting and cooking demos.

The five-day schedule is packed with pop up restaurants, fundraisers, food growing and even a film screening – with so much happening we hope to see you there supporting the fantastic variety of food businesses and organisations Streatham has to offer.

SCHOOLS RECIPE COMPETITION

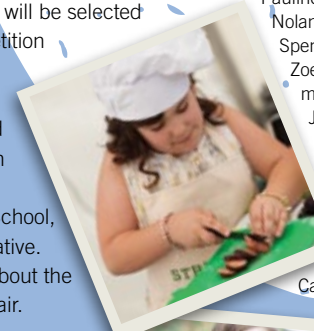

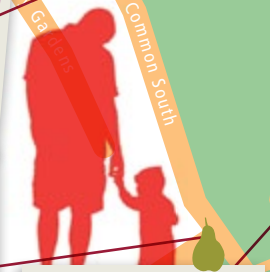


