The competition final will take place at our Sunday Food Fair on 7th June with the overall winning dish cooked in our Demo Tent (see p13).

As part of this, Rosie Boycott, chair of the London Food Board, will visit Hitherfield Primary School on 3rd June to meet the school's winner and taste their dish. She will be harvesting salad with pupils in their Edible Playground and hearing

more about how the school is engaging children in healthy eating as one of Lambeth's lead schools in the GLA's Flagship Food programme. Festival-goers can find out more about the programme at our Sunday Food Fair.




